



- 1. Attach Back Assembly (A) to Frame/Seat Assembly (B) using Screw (E)
- & Back Mounting Cap, Left & Right. (F). 2 Places. NOTE: See "L" or "R" on Caps and arrows to be assembled outward.
- 2. Insert Casters (D) firmly into the Frame/Seat Assembly (B). 4 Places.



Chairs with Tablet Assembly

 Attach Tablet Assembly (C) to Frame/Seat Assembly (B) using Screw included with Tablet Assembly.



NOTE:

Periodically (Every 90 days) make sure screws are fully tightened.

FEATURE INSTRUCTIONS

- Seat Adjustment.
 Lifts upward 92° to allow nesting & stacking.
- 2. Arm Adjustment
 Lifts upward 70° to allow nesting & stacking.
- 3. Tablet Adjustment
 Automatically rotates to side position
 when tablet rotates 60° forward or 90°
 upward.

Note: Tablet maximum weight capacity 100lbs.
