## Standard Washing Instructions

The attractive raised rubber-reinforced face patterns of Waterhog mats trap dirt and water, keeping them off carpets and floors. These products are perfect for most applications inside or out.

- For best results, utilize the cleaning method shown below
  - 1. Vacuum regularly/daily in high traffic applications, weekly in lower traffic
  - 2. applications.
  - 3. Extract, clean or hose off as needed to remove heavy soil.
  - 4. Hang mats to dry.
  - 5. Mats should be dry before placing back in service.
